Applicants sought for apprentice training program

CLEVELAND – Officials of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority (RTA) join Mayor Jane Campbell and City Council President Frank Jackson to encourage applicants to apply for the January class of the Union Construction Industry Partnership-Apprenticeship Skills Achievement Program (UCIP-ASAP). The deadline is Nov. 28.

This program provides participants with skills that are needed for job opportunities on construction projects, such as the \$200 million Euclid Corridor Transportation Project.

“The construction jobs are here,” says RTA CEO and General Manager Joe Calabrese. “Let’s be sure that local residents are qualified to do the work.”

Applicants must:

- **Be residents of Cleveland or Cuyahoga County.**
- **Have the legal right to work.**
- **Live in the United States.**
- **Have a high school degree or G.E.D.**
- **Be at least 18 years old.**

African-Americans, Latinos, women and the economically disadvantaged are encouraged to apply.
