Euclid Avenue vehicle on display on Public Square

CLEVELAND -- One of the proposed vehicles for the Euclid Corridor Transportation Project will be on display today on Public Square from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Any stations that want to use it for live shots should call Jerry Masek, 216-566-5211.

The vehicle is 60 feet long -- 20 feet longer than a normal bus -- and has bellows in the middle to allow it to make turns.

It looks more like a monorail than a bus, and is powered by a diesel-electric motor.

It is unlike anything Clevelanders have ever seen, and it will definitely "turn heads."

The vehicle is in town for test runs through Dec. 19.
