## **RTA Trustees meet Tuesday to hear Euclid Corridor update**

CLEVELAND -- The Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority (RTA) will meet at 9 a.m. on Tuesday, Sept. 12, in the Board Room on the first floor of the RTA Main Office, 1240 W. Sixth St.

At 9 a.m., a Committee of the Whole Board meets to hear an update on the status of the Euclid Corridor Transportation Project.

Cleveland City Council members are slated to consider the RTA inter-agency agreement at their meeting on Monday, Sept. 11. The agreement calls for the City to spend some \$17 million on a project totaling \$292 million.

If City Council approves the inter-agency agreement on Monday, then the RTA Board will convene a special meeting on Tuesday to approve the agreement and send it to federal officials.
