RTA holds two meetings this week for Corridor Project

CLEVELAND -- Officials of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority (RTA) will hold public meetings tonight, Wednesday, Jan. 22, and tomorrow, Thursday, Jan. 23, to update the community on the progress of the \$246-million Euclid Corridor Transportation Project.

Each meeting lasts from 5:30-7:30 p.m. The sites are:

- **Wednesday, Jan. 22:** Liberty Hill Baptist Church, 8206 Euclid Ave., in Midtown Cleveland.
- **Thursday, Jan. 23:** Thwing Center, CWRU, 11111 Euclid Ave., in University Circle.

The Project will affect Euclid Avenue and some parallel streets from Public Square to the Louis Stokes Station at Windermere in East Cleveland. Construction is set to begin in 2004, with completion targeted for 2006.
