RTA hosts Oct. 16 forum for public art

CLEVELAND -- RTA will host a public forum on Wednesday, Oct. 16, to start the process of developing a master plan for art along the Euclid Corridor.

Public art is a part of the \$220 million Euclid Corridor Transportation Project.

The meeting will be held from 5:30-7:30 p.m. Wednesday, Oct. 16, at the Maxine Goodman Levine College of Urban Affairs at Cleveland State University, 1717 Euclid Ave.

The meeting is being coordinated by Cleveland Public Art (CPA), which has been hired by RTA to develop and implement a master plan for public art in the Corridor. The vendor is working closely with RTA's Arts in Transit Committee, a volunteer group of community art activists.

Special guests from Houston and St. Louis will make presentations.
