Two public meetings set for Euclid Corridor Project

CLEVELAND -- Officials of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority (RTA) will hold two public meetings this week to update residents on the \$168-million Euclid Corridor Transportation Project.

Thursday, Sept. 30, from 5:30-7 p.m., at the Liberty Hill Baptist Church, 8206 Euclid Ave. This site is served by several RTA bus lines, including the #6 route.

Friday, Oct. 1, from 10-11:30 a.m., in the first-floor Board Room at RTA's Main Office Building, 1240 W. Sixth St., in the Warehouse District. The site is served by the #147 loop bus, which connects to Tower City and Public Square.

Both buildings are handicapped accessible.
